

Peaches, Pear, Plums, & Quince Trees



Reliance Peaches

Reliance is tops in quality — Fruits are medium to large, round, bright red attractive cheeks splashed over a yellow skin which is honey sweet, fine-flavored and comes free from the pit. The stone will not cling, even in coldest, driest seasons. The pit is smaller than any other peach. Fruit ripens about mid-August. One of the greatest tree finds of all time.

Produce delicious fruit after 25° below zero

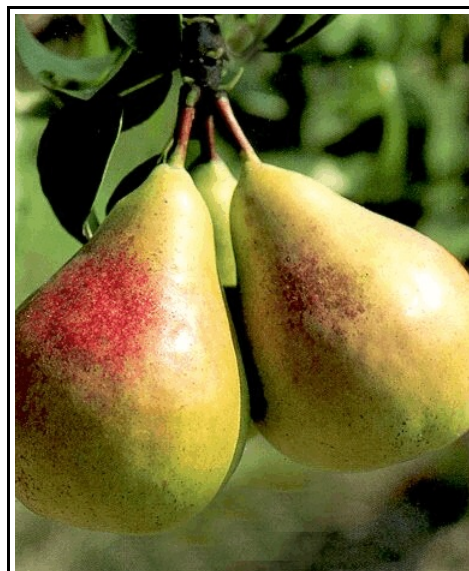


Shiro Plum

No other yellow plum touches the Shiro in both appearance and taste. Sheer, golden yellow skin covers the juiciest of crisp plum flesh. This one is delightful to look at and delicious to eat fresh or canned. Ripens in late July - early August. Pollinate with Santa Rosa. Z 5

Santa Rosa Plum

Produces plums that are large, conical, juicy, flavorful, purplish crimson with a pale bloom. One of the most frequently planted with fruit that is firm and of good quality. Z5-8



Flemish Beauty Pear

These are beauties with smooth green skins flushed with red and a classic pear shape. The flesh is very white and fairly dense, with a typical stoney pear texture. Unlike most pears, it's self-fertile, although it will do better with another mid-season blooming variety nearby. It should never be allowed to ripen on the tree. The ripening process is completed in storage where the pears will ripen more evenly. Z4



grows quickly. They have tender orange-yellow pulp with a golden skins and is excellent for cooking or eating fresh off the tree. The fragrance and taste is that of a juice citrus orange. Orange is easy to slice and its aromatic quality makes it very popular. Z 5-8
