

Franklin County Soil & Water Conservation District still has Cortland, McIntosh, Macoun, Empire and Freedom apple trees as well as Santa Rosa and Shiro Plum trees left at low sale prices. All fruit trees have to be ordered at least one day ahead of when you wish to pick them up.

There are also different colored lilacs left. We have pink and lavender pink: Anabel, Katherine Hevemeyer, Beauty of Moscow, and the reblooming S. Josee Lilacs; blue President Lincoln and President Grevy lilacs; deep maroonpurple Pocahontas and Agincourt lilac as well as a few other lilacs.

There are a limited number of small black walnut trees at \$4 each. Comfrey, catnip, spearmint, periwinkle for shady spots and a high bush American cranberry bush wait new homes.
