

Erosion Control Practices Class
for EARTHWORK CONTRACTORS and CEOs

A late fall class will be held on November 2nd at the Masonic Hall on Rte 2 in New Sharon. Call now to get on the list to be contacted in October or register now before the end of September and save \$5.

This all day class including lunch, refreshments, and materials is offered at \$70 per person before Sept. 29th and \$75 after that date. We ran out of room at our April session and had to turn people away so register early. If you have a group of 4 or more people and register early, take another \$2/person off the cost.

By attending this basic & advanced training session you qualify to become Certified by the DEP in Erosion and Sediment Control Practices. You will have the opportunity to learn about new state of the art erosion control techniques as well as ways to save time and money on your construction projects. Besides, you will not want to miss out on the benefits provided by the program including: discounts on erosion control products, accelerated permitting, and free advertising. This class will help you become prepared to comply with legislation regulating soil disturbance work within 250 feet of waterbodies that takes effect Jan. 1, 2013.

The day's schedule starts with registration at 8 a.m. followed by Bill LaFlamme's Introduction to the certification program- Why is erosion control needed? at 8:25. DEP staff will review "laws and regulations requiring erosion control" and "erosion and how it happens" between 9:30 and 11:30. Bill will conclude the morning session with Erosion Control Best Management Practices. After the lunch provided by the Masonic Hall, the afternoon session will start at 1 p.m. with erosion control planning/elements of an erosion control plan, followed by a BMP Jeopardy Competition, an exercise applying topics presented - MDOT Staff, contractor certification program – Next Steps, concluding with a course evaluation and issuing of certificates.
