Forestry Workshop Offers Credits for Master Loggers

Master Loggers will have an opportunity to receive CEU credits for attending the Farm Bill Forestry workshop being hosted by Franklin County Soil & Water Conservation District in the North Dining Hall at the University of Maine at Farmington on Tuesday, March 24 from 6 - 8:30 p.m.

By attending a free workshop being held in conjunction with the session loggers will be eligible to receive credits. This workshop is also open to all forested landowners throughout Franklin and Oxford Counties as well as anyone else who wishes to learn more about the program.

Andy Shultz from the Maine Forest Service and Sally Butler from the USDA's Natural Resource Conservation Service will be among the workshop presenters. There will be a brief update on forestry as it relates to the 2008 Farm Bill with information on available cost share money. There will also be discussion on the program flowchart for land owners with time for questions and answers.
